HOUSEFLIES, FRUIT FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, BLACKFLIES, SKIPPER FLIES, BLOWFLIES AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 2 to 3 seconds per 1000 cubic feet Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects Keep nozzle in constant motion Repeat application every 4 weeks if necessary

COCKROACHES, WATER BUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, SCORPIONS, SPIDERS, MILLIPEDES, CENTIPEDES, SOW BUGS AND PILL BUGS Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible Repeat application every 4 weeks if necessary

ANTS Spray trails, nests and points of entry Spray on ants where possible Repeat application every 4 weeks if necessary

INDIAN MEAL MOTHS, ANGOUMOIS GRAIN MOTHS Close doors and windows, direct spray into all parts of room, especially around stored food product containers, pallets and darkened areas Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space Keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment Repeat application every 4 weeks if necessary

EXPOSED STAGES OF CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES, RED FLOUR BEETLES, RICE WEEVILS, GRANARY WEEVILS, GRAIN

MITES Spray into cracks and crevices, around cartons or containers, or other areas where these insects tend to congregate For crack and crevice treatment, spray to the point of dampness but not runoff Spray 30 seconds for each 100 square feet of surface Keep area closed for 45 minutes to one hour after treatment Repeat application every four weeks if necessary Infested stored food products in the home should be disposed of

CARPET BEETLES Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets Repeat application every 4 weeks if necessary

BEDBUGS Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams Take beds apart and spray into all joints After mattress is dry cover with mattress cover and sheet Do not use mattress without cover Treat baseboards, moldings and floors Spray to the point of dampness but not runoff Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before reuse Repeat treatment every 4 weeks if necessary

To control *CLOTHES MOTHS AND CARPET BEETLES* on wool and other proteinaceous fibers Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages, directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices Spray to the point of dampness but not runoff After airing, infested articles may be treated by spraying lightly, keeping nozzle at least 3 feet from fabric to avoid staining. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use

To control HOUSE DUST MITES (DERMATOPHAGOIDES SPP) that may cause asthma, hay fever, rhinitis, watery eyes and sneezing. One treatment lasts for up to 8 weeks. On Upholstered Furniture – test fabric in an inconspicuous area to insure dyes will not bleed. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you Depress valve and spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches Spray all fabric surfaces to the point of dampness but not runoff Do not use on delicate fabrics Allow furniture to dry thoroughly before using On Carpets – spray over entire carpet to the point of dampness but not runoff Hold the nozzle approximately 12 to 18 inches from the carpet surface and spray in a sweeping motion Use an overlapping pattern to insure total coverage After application, brush the surface of the carpet with a broom or brush to insure deep penetration. Allow carpet to dry thoroughly before reentering the treated area. Drying time can be accelerated by using a fan Vacuum entire area once dry Since vacuuming stirs dust up in the air those with allergies should have another person vacuum or should wear a dust mask and use a vacuum with high efficiency particulate (HEPA) filter On Mattresses – spray the top, bottom and sides of mattresses to the point of dampness but not runoff, paying particular attention to tufts and seams. Allow to dry thoroughly before using After mattress is dry cover with mattress cover and sheet Do not use mattress without cover

FLEAS AND TICKS (ADULTS AND LARVAE) Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering, with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards and window and doorframes Spray to the point of dampness but not runoff Infested upholstered furniture may also be treated with this product A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use

To kill *LICE AND LOUSE EGGS* Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Hold

container upright with nozzle away from you Depress valve and spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Spray each square foot for 3 seconds. Spray only those garments and parts of bedding, including mattresses and furniture, that cannot be either laundered or dry cleaned. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use

To control *FLEAS*, *TICKS AND LICE ON DOGS* Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair, spraying the parted fur in short bursts, directly behind the hand, to ensure penetrating the coat Dampen the fur up to the head Repeat application every 2 weeks, if necessary

OUTDOORS All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses

- (1) Treatment to soil and vegetation around structures,
- (2) Applications to lawns, turf, and other vegetation,
- (3) Applications to building foundations, up to a maximum height of 3 feet

Other than applications to building foundations, all outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors, and eaves) are limited to spot and crack-and-crevice applications only

Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off Do not make applications during rain
