The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.



"To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

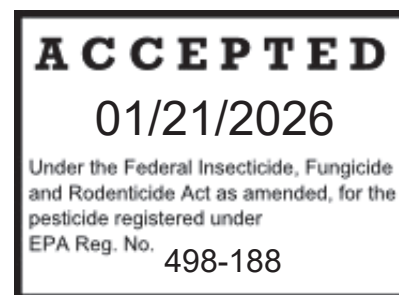

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean water mark. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Drift and runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas.

This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are actively visiting the treatment area.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

We recommend that those with asthma or severe allergies consult a doctor before using this product

and have someone else apply the product.

Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants intended for aesthetic purposes or climatic modification and being grown in ornamental gardens or parks, or on golf courses or lawns and grounds.

Do not use in food areas of food/feed-handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas.

In the home, all food-processing surfaces and utensils must be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food must be covered or removed.

Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

INDOORS

HOUSEFLIES, FRUIT FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, BLACKFLIES, SKIPPER FLIES, BLOWFLIES AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 2 to 3 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Repeat application every 4 weeks if necessary.

COCKROACHES, WATER BUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, SCORPIONS, SPIDERS, MILLIPEDES, CENTIPEDES, SOW BUGS AND PILL BUGS: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat application every 4 weeks if necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat application every 4 weeks if necessary.

INDIAN MEAL MOTHS, ANGOUMOIS GRAIN MOTHS: Close doors and windows, direct spray into all parts of room, especially around stored food product containers, pallets and darkened

areas. Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment. Repeat application every 4 weeks if necessary.

EXPOSED STAGES OF CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES, RED FLOUR BEETLES, RICE WEEVILS, GRANARY WEEVILS, GRAIN MITES: Spray into cracks and crevices, around cartons or containers, or other areas where these insects tend to congregate. For crack and crevice treatment, spray to the point of dampness but not runoff. Spray 30 seconds for each 100 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45 minutes to one hour after treatment. Repeat application every four weeks if necessary. Infested stored food products in the home should be disposed of.

CARPET BEETLES: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat application every 4 weeks if necessary.

BEDBUGS: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. After mattress is dry cover with mattress cover and sheet. Do not use mattress without cover. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Spray to the point of dampness but not runoff. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before reuse. Repeat treatment every 4 weeks if necessary.

To control ***CLOTHES MOTHS AND CARPET BEETLES*** on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages, directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. Spray to the point of dampness but not runoff. After airing, infested articles may be treated by spraying lightly, keeping nozzle at least 3 feet from fabric to avoid staining. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use.

To control ***HOUSE DUST MITES (DERMATOPHAGOIDES SPP.)*** that may cause asthma, hay fever, rhinitis, watery eyes and sneezing. One treatment lasts for up to 8 weeks. **On Upholstered Furniture** – test fabric in an inconspicuous area to insure dyes will not bleed. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Depress valve and spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Spray all fabric surfaces to the point of dampness but not runoff. Do not use on delicate fabrics. Allow furniture to dry thoroughly before using. **On Carpets** – spray over entire carpet to the point of dampness but not runoff. Hold the nozzle approximately 12 to 18 inches from the carpet surface and spray in a sweeping motion. Use an overlapping pattern to insure total coverage. After application, brush the surface of the carpet with a broom or brush to insure deep penetration. Allow carpet to dry thoroughly before reentering the treated area. Drying time can be accelerated by using a fan. Vacuum entire area once dry. Since vacuuming stirs dust up in the air those with allergies should have another person vacuum or should wear a dust mask and use a vacuum with high efficiency particulate (HEPA) filter. **On Mattresses** – spray the top, bottom and sides of mattresses to the point of dampness but not runoff, paying particular attention to tufts and seams. Allow to dry thoroughly before using. After mattress is dry cover with mattress cover and sheet. Do not use mattress without cover.

FLEAS AND TICKS (ADULTS AND LARVAE): Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering, with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards and window and doorframes. Spray to the point of

dampness but not runoff. Infested upholstered furniture may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

To kill **LICE AND LOUSE EGGS**: Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Depress valve and spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Spray each square foot for 3 seconds. Spray only those garments and parts of bedding, including mattresses and furniture, that cannot be either laundered or dry cleaned. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use.

To control **FLEAS, TICKS AND LICE ON DOGS**: Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair, spraying the parted fur in short bursts, directly behind the hand, to ensure penetrating the coat. Dampen the fur up to the head. Repeat application every 2 weeks, if necessary.

OUTDOORS

For soil or foliar applications, do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.

Do not apply the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur.

Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment.

Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff.

All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

1. Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;
2. Perimeter band treatments of 7 feet wide or less from the base of a man-made structure to pervious surfaces (e.g., soil, mulch, or lawn);
3. Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level;

Other than applications to building foundations, all outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors, and eaves) are limited to spot and crack-and-crevice applications only.

Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2 ft. by 1 ft. or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.).

To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.

Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff.

FOR THE CONTROL OF GARDEN INSECTS: For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill **JAPANESE BEETLES** hit by spray, as well as **WHITEFLIES, APHIDS, EXPOSED THRIPS, SPIDER MITES, RED MITES AND LEAF MINERS**.

Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours).

Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application.

Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph.

May be used on plants, as well as a multipurpose spray in small gardens and for spot treatments of incipient insect infestations to prevent spreading in large garden areas.

May also be used on other plants such as African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, crassula, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwood, English ivy, euonymus, fuschia, geraniums, grape vine, Kentia palm, laurel, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering Jews and zinnias.

Effective when used as directed against **WHITEFLIES, APHIDS, SPIDER AND RED MITES, EXPOSED THRIPS, LACE BUGS, JAPANESE BEETLE, PAVEMENT ANTS, CLOVER MITES AND ARMYWORMS**. When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Spray in one-second bursts. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90°F. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Re-apply as reinfestations occur.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Avoid freezing.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.
