Subject: Proposed Labeling Change in Response to  
PP Notice 87-6  
EPA Registration No. 790-140

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 2(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is amended, in accordance with the following comments.

1. Submit revised confidential statement of formula regarding the active ingredient. Be sure to report your product density.

2. Replace the statement, "All food processing surfaces should be cleaned during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before use," with "Food contact surfaces and equipment must be cleaned with an effective cleaning compound followed by potable water after treatment."

3. Add statement "Do not allow to flow" to the label to comply with Non-Food Animal section.

4. Add the following statement to the statement of formula comment.

Warning: Call your physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

Precaution: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected areas with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.


Directions: Wear protective clothing, including a breathing apparatus, when in vicinity of treated area.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

### HOW TO USE WHITMIRE CRACK AND CREVICE INJECTION EQUIPMENT:

Whitmire PT 150 for use only with injection tube and for injecting into cracks and crevices where insects may be hiding, living and breeding. Place injector tip 1/8" into cracks, crevices, holes and other small openings where insects may be a problem. Release approx. 1 second spray per spot. In serious infestation, if possible, place spots approx. 12" apart. In light infestation or inspection work place spots approx. 3 feet apart. See the additional directions below for effective control of specified insects.

**CRAWLING INSECTS: COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS, SPIDERS, FLEAS, EARWIGS, CRICKETS, SOWBUGS, MILLIPEDES.** Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, behind baseboards, coffee makers, meter boxes and manholes. Spray directly on insects in these locations where possible. Repeat as necessary.

**SILVERFISH.** Spray cracks and crevices in baseboards, door frames, bookcases and storage areas. Spray directly on insects in these locations where possible. Repeat as necessary.

**ANTS:** Spray into trails, nests, and points of entry around doors, windows, structural cracks and crevices. Spray directly on insects in these locations where possible. Repeat as necessary.

**GRAIN WEEVILS, FLOUR BEETLES, DRUG STORE BEETLES (in exposed adult and larvae stages):** Contact as many insects as possible when treating infested areas such as cracks and crevices, in wall voids, around windows and door frames, in machinery, and in dark secluded areas. Repeat as necessary.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**Storage:** Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, state, or local procedures.

**Container Disposal:** Replace cap and discard empty container in trash, sanitary landfill, or by other approved state and local procedures. Do not incinerate or puncture.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**Hazards to humans and domestic animals. CAUTION:** Avoid inhalation of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not treat where spray may go into fish-tank pumps.

In hospitals, remove patients from rooms prior to treatment. Keep rooms vacated for minimum of two hours and ventilate before patients are returned.

**Food processing areas of food plants:** Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using product for service work in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation. With the exception of Federally inspected meat and poultry plants, careful crack and crevice application for inspection purposes is permissible at all times.

**Physical or Chemical Hazards.** Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F. may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

Do not spray on plastic, painted or varnished surfaces or directly into any electronic equipment such as radios, televisions, computers, etc.
