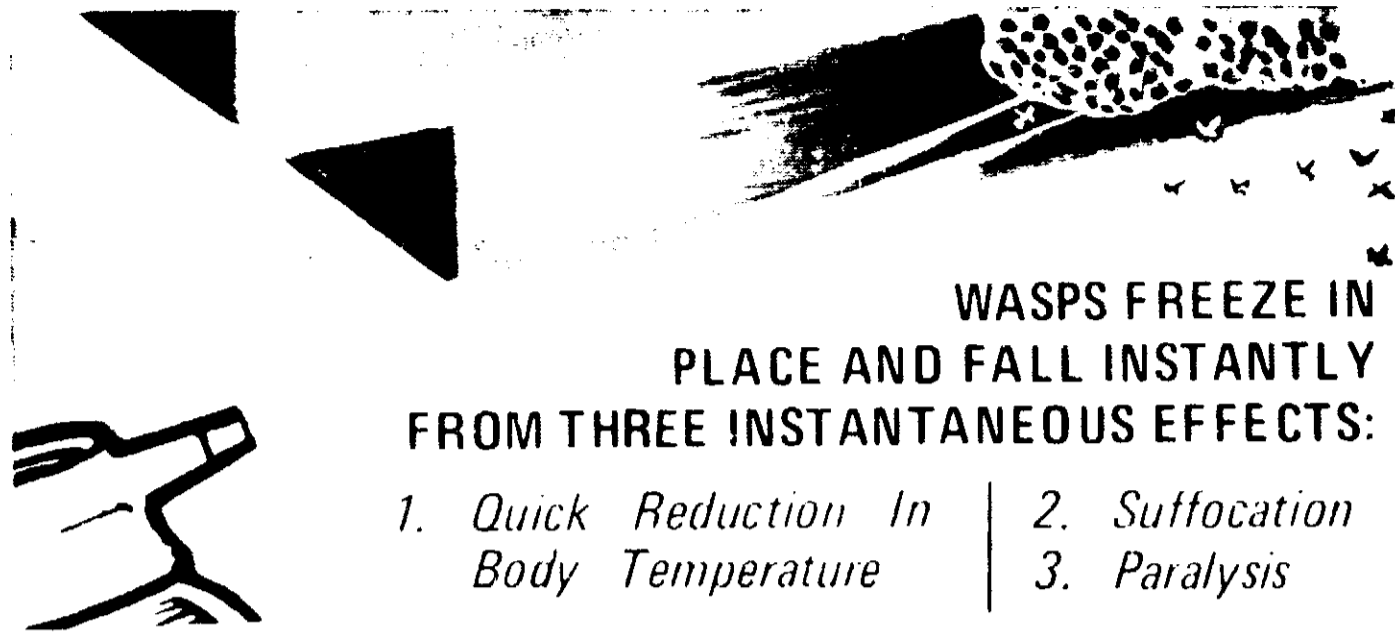

WASPS FREEZE IN PLACE AND FALL INSTANTLY FROM THREE INSTANTANEOUS EFFECTS:

Do not stand directly under nest being treated as falling insects may fall onto skin or clothing.

With wind at back of user spray nest from a distance of 8 to 10 feet. Spray until all of nest and wasps are contacted.

Spray with a sweeping motion any stimulated or stirred-up insects around nest opening. Afterwards, move forward to nest opening and spray liquid from 6 to 8 seconds directly into nest hole. This will suffocate bees in nest; other bees trying to return to nest will be repelled and will fly around and away harmlessly.

Spray directly on spiders and webs.

After treatment, remove nest, dry surface, and paint or carry out any other outdoor activity.

Tetrachloroethylene 32%, Trichloromonofluoromethane 20%, Dichlorodifluoromethane 20%, Petroleum Distillate 13.75%, Methylene Chloride 11%, Pine Oil 2.80%, Rotenone .12%, Other Related Cube Resins .28%, Pyrethrins I & II .05%.

Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. If contacted, wash with soap and water. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not expose to temperatures above 120°F. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.
