Do not stand directly under nest being treated as falling insects may fall onto skin or clothing

Wasps & Hornets With wind at back of user spray nest from a distance of 8 to 10 feet. Spray until all of nest and wasps are contacted

Yellow Jackets & Bees Spray with a sweeping motion any stimulated or stirred-up insects around nest opening. Afterwards, move forward to nest opening and spray liquid from 6 to 8 seconds directly into nest hole. This will suffocate bees in nest. Other bees trying to return to nest will be repelled and will fly around and away harmlessly

Spiders Spray directly on spiders and webs

Painters After treatment, remove nest, dust, surface, and paint or carry out any other outdoor activity

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, state, or local procedures
