The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act removing Dimethyl phthalate from the product is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Change the First Aid statement to read as follows:

Statement of Practical Treatment

For eyes: In case of contact flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

- 2. The statement "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" must appear on the label after the heading "Directions."
