USE DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

Wind should always be at back of user, and blowing toward object being sprayed.

WASPS: With valve nozzle pointed toward nest, at a distance of 6 to 8 feet, spray until nest and wasps are contacted.

YELLOW JACKETS & BEES: Locate underground nest. Depress valve and spray with a sweeping motion any stimulated or stirred-up insects around nest opening. Afterwards, move forward to nest opening and spray liquid from 6 to 8 seconds directly into nest hole. This will suffocate bees in nest. Other bees trying to return to nest will be repelled and will fly around and away harmlessly.

HORNETS: From 6 to 8 feet away, spray directly into nest openings. Make sure entire nest and all hornets are contacted.

SPIDERS: Spray directly on spiders and web.

To prevent falling insects from falling on skin and clothing, do not stand directly under nest being sprayed.
