STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place away from heat or open flame and inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do not re-use empty container. Do not puncture or incinerate. Replace cap and securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Start by applying a one-second burst of SECTROL Two-Way Flea Foam directly on haircoat near the pet's head. (NOTE: Sectrol Two-Way Flea Foam is an excellent product to use on nervous or hyperactive pets because it can be applied first into your palm while you face away from the animal.) Massage the foam into the haircoat until it disappears. Repeat this procedure making sure to thoroughly wet the entire haircoat and any exposed skin to assure adequate treatment.

Be sure to apply SECTROL Two-Way Flea Foam between the toes and foot pads and any other areas where fleas may hide to avoid contact with the insecticide.

The capsules in SECTROL Two-Way Flea Foam adhere to the haircoat and continuously release their active ingredients, thereby providing at least one week residual activity.

For best control, reapply SECTROL Two-Way Flea Foam weekly.

In addition to treating your pet directly, control of fleas in your pet's environment is important if you wish to eliminate fleas from your home.
