5. A 1-year storage stability study at room temperature must be submitted within 15 months of the date stamped on this Registration Notice.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

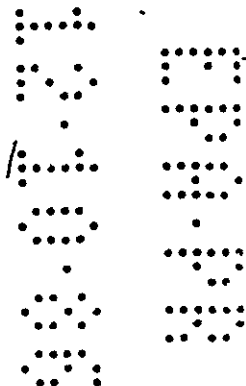

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

To protect woolens and other keratin containing materials: Brush articles or materials. Brush clean or dry clean, air. Remove persistent spots and stains by dry cleaning. Before spraying entire article, spray a small hidden area of fabric to determine if staining will occur holding dispenser at least one foot from garment. Spray thoroughly. Treated articles should be put into a darkened closet or other darkened storage such as cedar chests, storage drawers, or sealable black plastic fabric bags. For best protection clean and spray insides of closets or storage areas lightly misting surfaces before putting treated materials away. Treatment should be repeated every six months or as needed. Dry clean treated clothes before wearing.
