Dear Ms. Thomas:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide. Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

Please make the following changes to your label:

- 1. Under the "Spot and Crack and Crevice Application" section of your label, revise the first sentence to read "Spot or Crack and Crevice applications may be made while the facility is in operation, except in Federally inspected meat and poultry plants". In Federally inspected meat and poultry plants, insecticides may not be applied while the facility is in operation.
- 2. As per 40 CFR 180.436, add the following statement to the "Directions for Use" section: "Reapplications may be made at 10-day intervals."
- 3. Under the "First Aid" section of your label, revise the "IF ON SKIN" section to read "IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING".

Treat normal fly resting areas such as ceilings, upper corners of the area, around windows and doors, light fixtures and other surfaces known to attract tlies.
