DIRECTIONS FOR USE General Classification

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
Cover exposed foods, dishes, and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and closets in area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before reentry.
Place canister on table in center of area to be treated or near point of greatest infestation. Place newspapers under canister. Press tab down to locked position.
Leave building at once, and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place away from heat or open flame and inaccessible to children.
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash, sanitary landfill or by other approved state and local procedures. Do not incinerate or puncture.

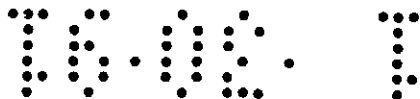
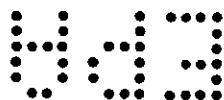
