Your Letters Dated June 6 and June 29, 1988 and November 15, 1989

The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, removing Methylene chloride and substituting another inert ingredient is acceptable.

The labeling submitted with your letter dated June 6, 1988 is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Note, this is the labeling without food processing area directions.

1. The petroleum distillate should be declared as an inert ingredient.
2. The ingredients statement should appear as follows:

Active Ingredients:

d-trans allethrin	0.300%
3-phenoxybenzyl-(1RS, 3RS; 1RS, 3SR)-2, 2-dimethyl-3-(2-methylprop-1-enyl) cyclopropanecarboxylate	0.200%
Inert Ingredients:	99.500%

Note that for d-trans allethrin, the related compounds are placed into the inert ingredients. For d-phenthrin, all the isomers are now lumped into one percentage (all active).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE General Classification

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Cover exposed foods, dishes, and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and closets in area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioning. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Use one unit for each 1,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Do not reenter the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before reentry.

Place container on table in center of room to be treated or rear point of greatest infestation. Place newspapers under container. Press tab down in locked position.

Leave building at once, and keep building closed for four hours before going out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place away from heat or open flame and inaccessible to children.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Residue resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Recycle cap and discard container in tank, curbside landfill or by other approved state and local procedures. Do not incinerate or burn.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS — CAUTION

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals:

Hazard if inhaled. Avoid inhalation of vapor. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Remove pets, birds, cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, storage, or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.
