HOW TO USE WHITMIRE CRACK AND CREVICE® INJECTION SYSTEM: Use Whitmire PT® 275 with the supplied actuator and injection tubes or other Whitmire equipment. Inject PT® 275 into cracks and crevices or void spaces where insects may be harboring, living and breeding. Place injector tip into cracks, crevices, holes and other small openings. Release approximately one-second of product. For light infestations move injector tip along cracks while treating at the rate of three linear feet per second. For heavy infestations move injector tip along at one linear foot per second. For closed voids calculate the void's cubic area and treat at the rate of five to ten seconds per three cubic feet. Several holes may be required in long-running voids. Repeat as necessary. To make a spot treatment release product onto the surface. Do not exceed 2 sq. ft for each spot treatment.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame and inaccessible to children.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where steel aerosol can recycling is available.
