DIRECTIONS FOR USE
SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING
It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
HOW TO USE WITH CRACK AND CREVICE® INJECTION SYSTEM: Whitmic PT® 300 is for use only with the supplied actuator and injection tubes. PT® 300 is to be injected only into cracks and crevices or void space where insects may be harboring, living and breeding. Concentrate treatment at insect activity sites. For light infestations, a minimum of 4 - 6 bait points is recommended per 100 sq. feet of treatment area. For heavy infestations, a minimum of 12-24 bait points is recommended per 100 sq. feet of treatment area. Place injector tip 1/2" into cracks and crevices, holes and other small openings. Release spray for approximately one-second per spot. Several holes may be required in long-running voids. Repeat as necessary.

Do not use in the food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food/feed is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but exclude areas where foods may be produced or held. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Non-food/feed areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries, and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

CRAWLING INSECTS: Cockroaches (including carbamate, organophosphate and organochlorine resistant strains) inject the recommended dosage into cracks and crevices and void spaces where insects may be harboring. These may include, but are not limited to, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, behind baseboards, washing machines, stoves, cabinets, meter boxes and man holes. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOOR USE: Use for control of cockroaches. Inject into cracks and crevices around windows and doors, porches, screens, eaves, patios, garages, under stairways and in crawl spaces and other areas where pests hide, such as tree holes and cracks in fences.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Not for storage in an area around the home.
STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from light or open flame and inaccessible to children.
CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash, sanitary landfill or by

other approved state and local procedures. Do not incinerate or puncture.
