DAIRY FARM USE: Miking Parlor and Milk Room - Close all windows and doors. Direct log upward and in all directions at a rate of 1 to 3 seconds per 1000 cu, ft, Keep room closed for 15 minutes after treatment, Open and ventilate before reoccupying. Cover milking utensils and milk to prevent contamination from spray and dead falling insects.

ANIMAL USE (Do not spray sick animals): From approximately 2 foot distance, fromughly spray entire animal as it is being released to pasture. Do not spray directly toward animals's eyes. Spot real withers, shoulders and back where saliva accumulated from head tossing
