

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PROD-UCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

DAIRY FARM USE: Milking Parlor and Milk Room - Close all windows and doors. Direct log upward and in all directions at a rate of 1 to 3 seconds per 1000 cu. ft. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after treatment. Open and ventilate before reoccupying. Cover milking ulensils and milk to prevent contamination from spray and dead failing insects.

ANIMAL LISE (Do not spray sick animals): From approximately 2 fool distance, thoroughly spray entire animal as it is being reased to pasture. Do not spray directly toward animals's eyes. Spot leat withers, shoulders and back where saliva accumulates from head tossing.

STANCHION BARN USE: Walk behind animals and direct spray over backs allowing 1 second per animal. For most effective results, apply each morning.

BEEF CATTLE OPERATIONS: In barns, close all windows and doors. Spray at the rate of 1 to 2 seconds per 1000 cu. ft. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following application. Ventilate area after freatment is complete. If area cannot be closed, double the dosage. Repeat application daily or as necessary.

HORSE BARNS AND STABLES: Close all windows and doors. Spray at a rate of 1 to 2 seconds per 1000 cu. If. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following application. Ventilate area after treatment is complete. If area cannot be closed, double the dosage. For animal application, lightly mist over the backs of horses and porties from a distance of at least two feet. Repeat application daily or as necessary.

POULTRY OPERATIONS: Use only in empty poultry houses (when birds are not present). Close all windows and doors. Spray at the rate #1 to 2 seconds per 1000 cu. ft. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following application. Ventilate area after treatment is complete. If area cannot be closed, double the dosage. Treat daily or as necessary.

HOG OPERATIONS: In hog houses, close all windows and doors. Spray at the rate of 1 to 2 seconds per 1000 cu. ft. Keep area closed for 15 minutes after application. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. If area cannot be closed, double the dosage. For animal application, direct spray over backs and spray for 1 to 2 seconds per hog. Do not spray directly toward animal's face or eyes. Repeat application daily or as necessary.

MUD DAUBER AND WASP NESTS: Spray mist directly on insects and their nests from approximately 2 ft. distance. Contacted insects will fly away from log. Applications should be made in take evening when insects are at rest. Spray into hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects as possible.

FLEAS: General Volumetric Treatment: Hold aerosol 35" above floor and direct spray toward floor and lower walfs at a rate of 10 seconds per 100 sq. feet making sure that all floor areas are contacted. Change litter before application. Keep area closed for 15 minutes. Remove animals before spraying. Open and verifiate before reoccupying. Repeat Irealment after 7 days or as necessary.

KENNELS AND CATTERIES: Remove animals before spraying. Ventifale after treatment is completed.

FLYING INSECTS (Cluster Fly, Flies, Fruit Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths): GENERAL VOLUMETRIC TREATMENT: Close all windows and doors and direct log upward at a rate of 1 to 3 seconds per 1000 cu. (t. Disperse in all tocalions. Keep area closed for 15 min. Open and ventilate before reoccupying. Papeal treatment as necessary.

FOR EXPOSED ADULT AND LARVAL STAGES OF - Carpel Beetles, Cigarelle Beetles, Confused Flour Beetles, Drug Store Beetles, Grain Mites, Granary Weevils, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, and Sawtoothed Grain Beetles. Contact as many Insects as possible, Inject into cracks and crevices of partires, cabinets and other places where insects harbon Apply around cartons, and containers, and other areas where these insects lend to congregate. GENERAL VOLUMETRIC TREATMENT: Apply 20 seconds per 1000 cu. ft. of space. Repeat treatment weekly or as insects appear. Infested stored products should be furnigated or treated by other effective methods using an approved product intended for his our pose.

OUTDOOR GROUND APILICATION: Flies, Gnats and Mosquiloes in open areas near building and in campgrounds. Best results are obtained when wind speed is five (5) MPH or less. Apply at a rate of 60-80 seconds per acre. Spray in wide swaths across area to be treated. Allow spray dr.ft to penetrate Consc. 531 age. Papeat treatment as necessary
