DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before opraying.

Houseflies, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees, Black Flies, Skipper Flies, Blow Flies and Small Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 2 to 3 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Firebrats, Crickets, Scorpions, Spiders, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs and Pillbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Indian Meal Moths, Angouncis Grain Moths: Close doors and windows, direct spray into all parts of room especially around stored food product concalners, pallets and darkened areas. Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic rest of space. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment. Repeat application as necessary. Back Panel (cont.):

Exposed stages of confused Flour Beetles, Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, Granary Weewils, Grain Mites: Spray into cracks and crevices, processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers or other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Spray 30 seconds for each 1000 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45 minutes to 1 hour after treatment. Repeat application as necessary. Infested stored food products in the home should be disposed of.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseloards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Lice and lice eggs Not For Use on Humans for Lice Control: Spray on an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect after drying, then spray entire area to be treated. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Depress valve and spray from a distance of 18 inches. Spray at the rate of 1 second of spray per each square foot. Thoroughly spray all mattresses, furniture or similar objects that cannot be laundered or dry cleaned. Do not use article until spray is dry. Repeat treatment as necessary.

To control **Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles** on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other stores directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated by spraying lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining.

In Animal Quarters and Milk Rooms: Remove animals prior to treatment. For rapid control of House Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees and Small Flying Moths, close windows and doors and spray at the rate of 2 seconds per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results, keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate after treatment is completed.

To Treat Livestock: To protect beef cattle, dairy cattle, goats, sheep, hogs and horses from attacks of Stable Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Face Flies, House Flies, Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats: Spray about 3 seconds on each side being careful to spray back, withers and forelegs thoroughly. Io protect from Face Flies, spray the face and head, but do not spray into eyes. Ropeat treatment when flies are troublesome.

For Swine: Do not ship animals for slaughter within 5 days of last treatment.

To control **Blood Sucking Lice:** Apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 3 weeks if required.

To control Poultry Lice, spray roosts, walls and nests or cages thoroughly. This

For control of Bedbugs and Mites in poultry houses, spray crevices of roost poles, cracks in walls, and cracks in nests where the bedbugs and mites hide.

Fleas and Ticks: (Adults and Larvae): Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor cover 4, with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

To control Fleas, Ticks and Lice on dogs. Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair, Spraying the parted fur in short bursts directly behind the hand to insure penetrating the coat. Dampen the fur up to the head. Repeat application weekly if necessary to control infestations. Do not use on old, sick or debilitated animals. NOTE: Not recommended for use on puppies less than four weeks old.

For the Control of Garden Insects: For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill Japanese Beetles hit by spray, as well as Whiteflies, Aphids, exposed Thrips, Spiders, Red Mites and Leafminers.

May be used on plants, as well as a multi-purpose spray in small gardens and for spot treatments of incipient insect infestations to prevent spreading in large garden areas.

May also be used on other plants such as African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwood, English ivy, euonymus, fuschia, geraniums, crassula, grape vine, Kentia palm, laurel, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering jews and zinnias.

Effective when used as directed against Whiteflies, Aphids, Spider and Red Mites, exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs, Japanese Beetles, Pavement Ants, Clover Mites and Army Worms. When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Spray in one second bursts. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90°F. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment as infestations occur.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area. Do not transport or store below 32'F.

Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose of in trajh. Do not incinerate or puncture. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
