STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

GENERAL INFORMATION

PT® 405 UltraGuard™ contains a flea growth regulator which affects the immature stages of fleas. PT® 405 UltraGuard™ can be used as a preventative treatment to prevent flea eggs from hatching and larvae from developing into adult fleas. If adult fleas are present in treated areas, a product which controls adult fleas should be used with PT® 405 UltraGuard™.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

All carpeted areas should be thoroughly vacuumed before treatment. Thoroughly treat infested areas such as rugs, carpets, pet beds and pet resting areas. Hold can at arms length directed toward the area to be treated. Use a sweeping motion to apply product and back away from treated area. 100 sq. ft. of area can be treated in approximately 10 seconds.

Use one 16 oz. can of PT® 405 UltraGuard™ per 1,500 sq. ft.

Cover aquariums and fish bowls and remove birds from area prior to treating. Treated areas should be vacated during application. OTHER THAN APPLICATOR DO NOT PERMIT HUMANS OR PETS TO CONTACT TREATED SURFACES UNTIL THE SPRAY HAS DRIED. Old pet bedding should be replaced with fresh, clean bedding after treatment. Do not treat Pets with this product. To control the source of flea infestation, pets inhabiting the treated premises should be treated with a product registered for application to animals.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL
