PT 370 is toxic to ants, however, it is most effective against the ant queen and causes an immediate halt of egg production and disappearance of worker brood. The disappearance of worker ants leads to the decline and eventual elimination of the ant colony. Apply when ants are actively foraging. This is typically when soil temperatures are greater than 60°F and 70°F. Consult your State Agricultural Experiment Station or State Extension Service for optimum timing and application. In cases where no infestation occurs or when very large mounds remain active, re-treat as necessary.

OUTDOORS

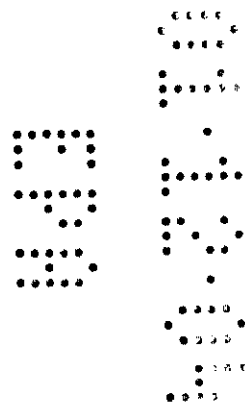

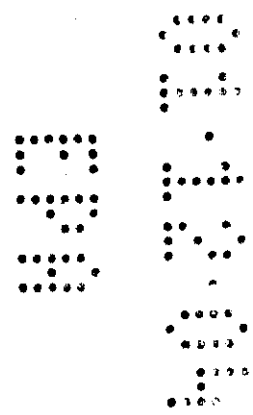

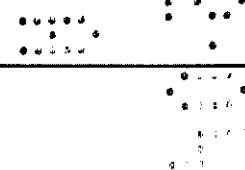
