CAUTION

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Whitmire PT<sup>®</sup> 320 is for use with the supplied actuator and injection tubes or other Whitmire approved devices. PT<sup>®</sup> 320 is to be injected into cracks and crevices, void spaces or other locations where insects may be harboring, living and breeding. Concentrate treatment at insect activity sites. For light infestations, a minimum of 4 - 6 bait points is recommended per 100 sq. ft. of treatment area. For heavy infestations, a minimum of 12 - 24 bait points is recommended per 100 sq. feet of treatment area. Approximately 0.25 to 0.50 grams of bait per placement is suggested. Place bait into cracks and crevices, holes, pipe chases, undersides of furniture, under drain plates, in or under trash containers, hidden surfaces around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors and windows, inside, behind and under cabinets, drawers and shelving, under and behind appliances such as, stoves, and refrigerators and in attics and crawl spaces. Also apply in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases and crawl spaces where insects hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces. Retreat as necessary.

Do not use in the food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food/feed is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but exclude areas where foods may be prepared or held.

In the home all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly wash before use. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed.

Non-food/feed areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries, and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

OUTDOOR USE: Use for control of cockroaches. Inject into cracks and crevices around windows and doors, porches, screens, eaves, patios, garages, under stairways and in open crawl spaces and other areas where pests hide, such as tree holes and cracks in fences.

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## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
