PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Wash with soap and warm water after use. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Flea Spray kills fleas and ticks. It contains a unique combination of ingredients that kills both adult and preadult fleas. Even kills fleas before they grow up to bite. NYLAR, a unique ingredient in this flea spray, continues to kill fleas for 120 days (4 months) by preventing their development into the adult biting stage. It reaches fleas hidden in carpets, rugs, drapes, upholstery, pet bedding, floor cracks. Protects your home from reinfestation and fleas buildup, your pets and family from bites. One treatment with this spray gives continuous flea protection for 120 days. Leaves no objectional odor or sticky mess and, used as directed, does not stain furnishings.

FLEAS & TICKS: SHAKE WELL. Hold can 2 or 3 feet from surfaces to be treated. Be sure to apply uniformly using a sweeping motion to carpets, rugs, drapes and all surfaces of upholstered furniture. Be sure to treat pet bedding as this is a primary hiding place for fleas. No need to remove pet bedding after treatment. DO NOT TREAT PETS. Use a registered flea control product on your pets in conjunction with this treatment. Retreat as necessary. Avoid wetting furniture and carpeting. A fine mist or spray applied uniformly is all that is necessary to kill fleas and ticks.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children. Keep container closed.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
