



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product contains a highly effective insecticide designed especially for use in automatic dispensers. The dispenser activates the metered valve every 15 minutes.

Usually the effectiveness of this product will be noticeable within one hour after the dispenser is activated. If less than 24 hour control is required, the dispenser should be set to start one hour before control is desired and run one hour after control is no longer needed. Keep in mind that such factors as air flow rate, size of space treated, humidity and room temperature all affect insect activity and control. Therefore, one unit per 6,000 cubic feet should be considered as an average need with adjustments made depending on specific conditions at place of usage. As with any method of insect control, best results are achieved when sanitation and other positive insect prevention practices are followed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Pesticide Disposal: Waste resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: This container may be recycled in aerosol recycling centers. At present, there are only a few such centers in the country. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label (DO NOT PUNCTURE!). If recycling is not available, wrap the container and discard in the trash.
