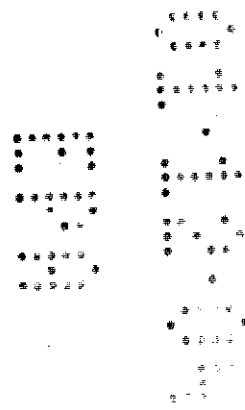

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

FIRST AID
