The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the pyrethrins, and piperonyl butoxide REDs, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.



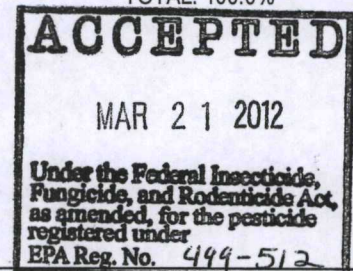

Remove or cover exposed foods, drinking water, dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and surfaces.

Remove pets and birds, cover and turn off fish aquariums before spraying. Turn off air flow systems in aquariums.

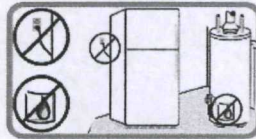
Cover waxed wood floors, waxed furniture and stereo or other plastic dust covers in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (newspaper may be used).

Close outside doors and windows.

Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerator, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

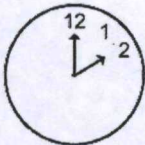
PICTOGRAM 3:
Unplug and Turn off Ignition Sources

To Start Fogging:

Place a chair, table or stand in the center of the room to be fogged. Cover with several layers of newspaper, paper towels or plastic tarp.

Shake Well Before Using. Tilt can AWAY from face (container sprays straight up). Press tab down in locked position to initiate application. Set fogger on covered stand.

Vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit or other structure immediately. Do no reenter for 2 hr.

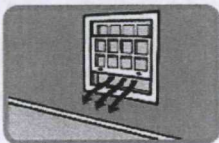


Do Not Re-Enter for two hours.
0.75" (w) x 0.75" (h)

Fill out and place hang-tag on the door to the treated area to alert family and others with access to the treated area not to enter for 2 hr.

Airing Out:

Wait 2 hr after application (until aerosols and vapors have dispersed), then ventilate the treated area by opening windows, vents and doors for 2 hr. If an odor is still detected, additional ventilation is required.
