


2. Make the following change to the label:

a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 499-513"

b. Make the following label revisions:

1. Data deficiencies were identified for storage stability and corrosion characteristics in the product chemistry review for this product. Therefore, Whitmire is obligated to submit a One Year Storage Stability (830.6317) study and a Corrosion Characteristics (830.6320) study on this product in support of this registration within one (1) year from the date of this registration.

3. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record before the product is released for shipment.

Whitmire should note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) document for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). Further, EPA's RED for products containing piperonyl butoxide was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide.

If the above conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

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FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

USE RESTRICTIONS

- Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined.
- Do not place metering device directly over or within 8 feet of exposed food, dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and food handling or preparation.
- Do not install within 3 feet of air vents.
- Carefully follow directions for the dispenser unit when installing the dispenser and replacing cans or conducting maintenance.

This product contains a highly effective insecticide formulation especially designed for use in automatic metered dispensers.

For Use with Automatic Metered Dispenser: One dispenser per 6,000 sq ft should be considered an average need, with adjustments made on specific conditions at place of usage. The dispenser activates the metered valve once every 15 min. Effectiveness of this product will be noticeable within 1 hr after the dispenser is activated. Recommended use is for 24 hr control; but if less than 24 hr control is required, the dispenser should be set to start 1 hr before control is desired and run 1 hr after control is no longer needed. Factors such as airflow rate, size of space treated, humidity and room temperature affect insect activity and control. Therefore, 1 unit per 6,000 sq ft of unobstructed space should be considered as an average with adjustments made depending on specific conditions at usage site. As with any method of insect control, best results are achieved when sanitation and other positive insect prevention practices are followed. It is suggested that the container be changed once a month (when operated on a 24 hr basis).

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Waste resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not puncture or incinerate! Empty container by using the product in accordance with the label directions. Offer empty container for recycling, if available, or place in trash if allowed by state and local regulations. If container is partly full, contact your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.
