The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following label revision provision(s):

Ingredient Statement section comment(s):

1. Revise the listing of "**INERT INGREDIENTS:**" to read "**OTHER INGREDIENTS:**".

First Aid Statement section comment(s):

2. Revise the "**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:**" statement to read "**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 - 20 min. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice."
3. Revise the existing last sentence within this text box to read "For additional information on this product (including health concerns, medical emergencies or pesticide incidents), you may call 1-800-225-3320, 24 hours/day, 7 days/week."

Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals subsection comment(s):

4. Insert the words "**Contains Petroleum Distillates.**" immediately preceding the existing 1<sup>st</sup> sentence within this subsection.
5. Revise the existing 5<sup>th</sup> sentence to read "Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling, and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. #### FIRST AID

This product contains a highly effective insecticide formulation especially designed for use in automatic metered dispensers.

**For Use with Automatic Metered Dispenser:** One dispenser per 6,000 ft<sup>3</sup> should be considered an average need, with adjustments made on specific conditions at place of usage. The dispenser activates the metered valve once every 15 min. Effectiveness of this product will be noticeable within 1 hr after the dispenser is activated. Recommended use is for 24 hr control; but if less than 24 hr control is required, the dispenser should be set to start 1 hr before control is desired and run 1 hr after control is no longer needed. Factors such as airflow rate, size of space treated, humidity and room temperature affect insect activity and control. Therefore, 1 unit per 6,000 ft<sup>3</sup> of unobstructed space should be considered as an average with adjustments made depending on specific conditions at usage site. As with any method of insect control, best results are achieved when sanitation and other positive insect prevention practices are followed. It is suggested that the container be changed once a month (when operated on a 24 hr basis).
