Enclosed in support of this action is a completed application (EPA Form 8570-1) and one copy revised labeling. The label is also being submitted in electronic format on a CD (with a signed label certification statement).

The label has been revised as follows to add or include:

the alternate brand name, Alpine® Total Release Aerosol Insecticide

 revisions required by EPA with the Notice of Pesticide Registration dated September 20, 2012. All revisions were made verbatim, except as follows:

5. The "FOR USE IN:" subsections were combined (alphabetically) and moved to the top the label directly below the "KILLS:" section

7. 4th bullet - text combined and reworded as, "Remove ALL animals, including pets and birds. Cover and..."

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

Final printed (marketplace) labeling bearing the alternate brand name noted herein will be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. Spanish translation/labeling will be incorporated into final printed labeling.



- Apply this product only as specified on this label.
- THIS PRODUCT IS FOR INDOOR USE ONLY.
- This product does not control bed bugs.
- This product is not for use in food and/or non-food areas of food handling establishments.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected applicators may initiate application. Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area for at least 2 hr, until aerosols, vapors and/or mists have dispersed.
- Remove pets and birds, and turn off fish aquariums before application.
- Remove all livestock animals prior to application.

Do not use in a room 5 ft x 5 ft or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms.

Fill out and place hang-tag on the door leading to the treated area to alert family and others with access to the treated area not to enter for 2 hr.

Before You Fog:

Open cabinets, cupboards, drawers, closets and doors in areas to be treated.




Remove or cover exposed foods, drinking water, dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and surfaces. Remove all open animal feed and water or cover exposed animal feed and water sources in the area to be treated.

Remove ALL animals, including pets and birds. Cover and turn off fish aquariums before initiating application. Turn off air flow systems in aquariums. Cover waxed wood floors, waxed furniture and plastic dust covers in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (newspaper may be used).

Close outside doors and windows.





Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e. refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

Fill out and place hang-tag on the door leading to the treated area to alert family and others with access to the treated area not to enter for 2 hr.

To Start Fogging:

Place a chair, table or stand in the center of the room to be fogged. Cover with several layers of newspaper, paper towels or plastic tarp.

Tilt can AWAY from face (container sprays straight up). Press tab down in locked position to initiate application. Set fogger on covered stand.

Vacate the treated house, individual apartment or other structure immediately. Do not reenter for 2 hr.

Airing Out:



Wait 2 hr after application (until aerosols and vapors have dispersed), then thoroughly ventilate, either mechanically or with natural airflow by opening windows, vents and doors before reentering. If an odor is still detected, additional ventilation is required.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place away from heat or open flame, in an area that is inaccessible to children and animals.
