"To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

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Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6. Remove or cover food/feed, dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, in the treatment area, or wash them before use. Apply as a Crack & Crevice, void, spot or general treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboards, under elements of construction, stainless steel equipment, shelving, machinery, storage areas, pallets, tables, chairs and other areas where listed pests may be harboring, traveling, breeding or entering the structure. Maximum use rate = 0.05 g ai/ln ft. Reapplications may be made at 3 day intervals when applying as a Crack & Crevice, void or spot treatment, or at 6 day intervals when applying as a general surface treatment.
