

TAT GO is a specially formulated Thiram with a water impervious binder that assures film retention under normal weathering up to 10 months at the more concentrated recommendations.

TAT GO will perform when used as directed and is non-injurious to plants.

HOW IT WORKS:

TAT GO has a disagreeable taste. Animals probably associate an odor with this undesirable taste and thus are discouraged from further feeding. The sensitivity of animals to repellents varies and sometimes complete control (especially for deer damage) is not attainable. TAT GO does not repel dogs.

HOW TO APPLY:

May be brushed or sprayed uniformly with any conventional equipment except close tolerance gear pumps. Apply when temperature is above freezing. Cover all potential feeding surfaces, including those that may be reached during deep snows. For Meadow Mouse damage in orchards, remove sod around trunks of trees and treat to soil line. For deer damage, spraying the distal 6 inches of the main laterals is often sufficient.

CAUTION: MAY CAUSE IRRITATION OF EYES, NOSE, THROAT AND SKIN. HARMFUL IF INHALED OR SWALLOWED.

Do not breathe spray mist. Do not get on skin, eyes, clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling.

In case of contact, flush with plenty of water; for eyes get medical attention.

This product is poisonous to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds.
