

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

Statement of Practical Treatment

If On Skin, wash with soap and water. If in eyes, rinse thoroughly with clean water. If swallowed, drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Note to Physicians: Atropine sulfate is antidotal and should be administered only if symptoms appear.

On the sides of the can you will find several indented sections. Simply apply pressure with key until they open (see illustration). Place the bait trays where you have noticed the infestation of roaches. TAT Roach Bait will take care of the rest. For best results, use 4-6 bait trays per 100 square feet of surface area to be treated. More bait trays may be used if infestation is great.

For a total control program, use in conjunction with TAT Liquid Aerosol Jet Stream.

EFFECTIVE -- CLEAN -- ECONOMICAL


For continuous good results, check regularly and replace every four weeks or as needed. Place bait trays where roaches are numerous -- on shelves, in drawers, baseboards, under sinks, stoves and refrigerators, in bathrooms, etc. As roaches are night feeders, they enter bait tray when it's dark. Death occurs soon after feeding. They leave bait tray, return to hiding places and die.

EFICAZ -- LIMPIO -- ECONOMICO

En los lados de la caja, vera tres secciones perforadas. Aplique presion en ellas, con una llave, hasta que se abran (vea la ilustracion). Coloque las carnadas de TAT Roach Bait donde hyan muchas cucarachas -- en estantes o anaqueles, avetas, zocalos o bases, debajo de fregaderos, estufas y refrigeradores, y en banos, etc. Como las cucarachas salen a comer de noche, entran en la bandejita que contiene la carnada, comen y regresan a sus escondites. Alli mueren rapidamente. [Spanish translation of: For best results, use 4-6 bait trays per 100 square feet of surface area to be treated. More bait trays may be used if infestation is great.]
