

**Application Instructions**

- Place bait trays where you have noticed infestation and where German roaches are numerous – on shelves, in drawers, baseboards, under sinks, stoves and refrigerators, in bathrooms, etc.
- Find indented sections on the sides of the can.
- Simply apply pressure with key until they open (see illustration).
- For best results use 4 to 6 trays [traps] per 100 square feet [2 to 3 trays per 50 square feet] of surface area to be treated. More bait trays may be needed if infestation is great.
- For continuous good results check regularly and replace every four weeks or as needed. Death occurs soon after feeding. German roaches leave bait tray and return to hiding places to die.
