DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

[Storage and Disposal]

Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) storage area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or open flame.
Disposal: Replace cap, wrap container and put in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate. [Alternate Disposal Directions: **Disposal:** This container may be recycled in aerosol recycling centers. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label (**Do not puncture!**). If recycling is not available, replace cap, wrap the container and put in trash.]

This product may be used both indoors (attics and other places where nests are built and where food or feed are not exposed) and outdoors on hornet and wasp nests. **Do not directly spray light-colored asbestos shingle roofs as dark stains may occur.**

To Kill Wasps and Hornets: Apply this product in the early morning or late evening when air temperature is cooler, most insects are in the nest and little activity is observed around the nest opening. Spray only if it is not windy. Stand a safe distance from the nest, not directly beneath it. Hold container upright at arms' length, point the actuator at nest and spray the opening of the nest. Then saturate rest of nest with spray. Treated insects will fall out of the nest and die. Any insects returning to the treated nest will also be killed. Do not attempt to spray insects while in flight. Wait 48 hours before removing the nest.
