The change in supplier for the active ingredient dichlorvos is acceptable.

The Confidential Statement of Formula dated October 14, 1987 is acceptable and has been made a part of the record for this product.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Declare the first active ingredient as Dichlorvos [2,2-Dichlorovinyl dimethyl phosphates].
2. Delete "Essential Oils" and "Petroleum distillate" and include them in the total percentage of inert ingredients, since these ingredients are not active.
3. Add an asterisk to INERT INGREDIENTS and a footnote "*Contains Petroleum distillate."

MOSQUITOES, HOUSE FLIES, SAND FLIES, GNATS, CHIGGERS: Apply as spot treatment only. Spray directly on outside surfaces of screens, doors, and window frames and other darkened areas and wherever these insects congregate. Mutation will continue to kill flying insects after it is sprayed.

BED BUGS: Take bed apart and spray surfaces of beds, mattress, and bed frame. Do not spray general surface of mattress before reuse.
BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray localized areas where pet rests. Replace bedding before allowing reuse by animal.
CARPET BEETLES: Make localized application to areas in cracks and under carpets where insects may be found.

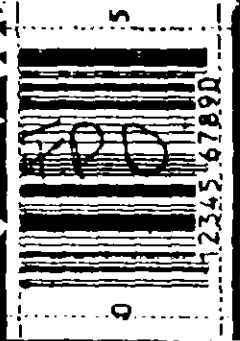
FLEAS, BROWN DOG TICKS, FOR SPOT TREATMENT: Use in outdoor areas where there is no vegetation.
ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SPIDERS, SILVERFISH, CRACKS, CREVICES, BASEBOARDS, ARCHES, AND TRAYS: and in the home. TAT will penetrate into cracks and even into crevices for residual control of crawling insects. Use TAT ROACHES.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:
HAZARDS TO HUMANS (AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS):
CAUTION: HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED, INHALED OR NOT APPLIED TO HUMANS OR PETS. Do not contaminate commercial food preparation areas or in areas not to be used as a space spray. Do not let children or pets contact. Remove pets from room and cover aquaria and fish bowls. Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, vinyl, or asphalt tile. This product is intended for household use.
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:
If swallowed—**CAUTION: CONTAINS PETROLEUM DISINFECTANT.** Give victim one or two glasses of milk or some activated charcoal immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated. Vomiting may be induced. Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if on skin. Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin. If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call physician.
NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Dichlorvos is an organophosphorus compound. Inhibition is present, atropine sulfate by injection should be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS—EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE: Do not use on electrical equipment in the use area. After using out phase is electrical current. Do not smoke in the use area. Contain in airtight container. Exposure to temperatures above 100°F may cause explosion.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:
STORAGE: Do not store near heat or open flame.
DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper or other heavy paper. Do not incinerate or puncture.
