DISPOSAL: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper, and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is for residential use. **To Operate:** Shake can before using. Hold container upright. Point valve opening away from face and press button.

OUTDOORS

To reduce annoyance of houseflies, mosquitoes, gnats and small flying moths: Spray area infested with these flying insects. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at a rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these pests treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

Controls insects on the following plants and ornamentals: Ornamental Cherry, Crepe Myrtle, Ornamental Crabapple, Rose, Andromeda, Azalea, Spirea, Chrysanthemum, Gardenia, Purple Passion, Vine Peony, Oleander and Arborvitae.

Eastern Tent Caterpillar,
Aphids, Cankerworm,

Beetle, Mealybug, Ants,
Caterpillar, Box Elder Bug

When sprayed directly on insects, this spray will kill insects listed. Caution should be taken when spraying new tender growth on young plants. When spraying, hold can 18-24 inches from plant. For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Mist the plants lightly. Use a slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray both sides of a row. Repeat as needed. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90°F.

USE INDOORS TO KILL:

Flies
Mosquitoes
Small Flying Moths
Gnats
Wasps

Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

Cockroaches
Ants
Crickets

Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames and trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

Carpet Beetles, Ticks,
Fleas, Flea Larvae

Spray top and underside of rugs. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. Replace cap and discard containers in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If in Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

If on Skin Or Clothing: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention.

If Inhaled: Remove to fresh air if effects occur and call a physician.

If Swallowed: Get immediate medical attention.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is toxic to fish. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark.

Money Back Guarantee: If this product fails to kill the insects listed, when used as directed, mail container to factory for full refund.
