Dear Ms. Davis:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1) Please reinstate related compounds plus percentage for permethrin in the ingredient statement. These related compounds still appear on the labeling for your source products and it's active/inert status has not been determined.
- 2) Reinstate the asterisk and cis/trans ratio for permethrin since the toxicity of this chemical varies by ratio.
- 3) Please remove all "repeat treatments as necessary" statements and provide the minimum amount of time between applications. This should be based on the efficacy data of the product you cited.

- 4) We could not find any efficacy data in your file for the following pests: cockroaches, Brown Dog Ticks, fleas, mosquitoes and flies. Please submit or cite (with MRID numbers) accepted data for all of the above insects with your final printed labeling or remove them from your label.

General

Do Not Use as a Space Spray

Use this residual spray only as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to kill cockroaches [roaches], fleas, silverfish, ticks, waterbugs and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet, but not to the point of runoff. Repeat as needed.

In the home cover all food processing surfaces and utensils during treatment or thoroughly wash before use. Cover or remove exposed food. Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held. Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries, vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, closets and storage areas (after canning or bottling).

For Spot Treatment

[To Kill] Ants, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches [Roaches], Crickets, Earwigs, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders	Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Directly spray pests driven out of hiding places. For ants, apply to ant trails, around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.
[To Kill] Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas	Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards; window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Remove old pet bedding and replace with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not spray pets with this product. Prior to pets' reentry into treated area, treat pets with a flea and tick control product registered for use on pets.
Flies, Mosquitoes	Use only outdoors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the premises. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) of porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.
