

We would also like to include minor label revisions that fall under PR Notice 98-10.

We have enclosed two copies of the label, one with changes highlighted.







**Shake Well Before Use. Do Not Use as a Space Spray.**

Use this spray only as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to kill cockroaches [roaches], fleas, silverfish, ticks, waterbugs and other insects listed below. 
