Dear Sir/Madam:

By Notification we are changing the Storage and Disposal language to comply with the Final Rule "Pesticide Management and Disposal; Standards for Pesticide Containers and Containment." We are also making minor label revisions that fall under PR Notice 98-10.

We are submitting this Notification of Storage and Disposal language changes as a separate Notification to our Notification submitted November 10, 2009 that was denied and is being processed as an amendment. We are submitting this separate Notification to allow for the new language required by PR Notice 2007-4 to be reviewed separately as suggested in my phone conversation with Kimberly Nesci February 4, 2010.

The label will be revised with our 8 month response to the Product Data Call In for PBO, MGK-264, Pyrethrins and Permethrin following the changes required by the PDCI.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 2007-4, PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR §156.10 and 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula for this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 2007-4, 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46 and 156.10, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

This product kills ants, cockroaches, confused flour beetles, crickets, fleas, houseflies, mosquitoes, rice weevils, sawtoothed grain beetles, small flying moths, sowbugs, spiders and brown dog ticks.

#### **Shake Well Before Use**

**DO NOT** use more than one fogger per room. **DO NOT** use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. **DO NOT** use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. **Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.).** Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face when releasing. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before reentry.

**To operate valve:** Place several layers of newspaper or a pad on a stand or table in the center of the room. Point valve opening away from face. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for 2 hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in 2 weeks or when necessary.

**To kill fleas and brown dog ticks:** Destroy pet's old bedding and replace with clean, fresh bedding after treatment is completed. Use product as above. Prior to pets' reentry into treated area, treat pets with a flea and tick control product registered for use on pets.

**{Storage and Disposal}**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) storage area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or open flame.
