- d. Please correct the concentration of the active ingredient Esfenvalerate from 4.0% to 2.0% in the Confidential Statement of Formula dated December 4, 1998.

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- e. Either delete "repeat as needs" or indicate a repeat interval based upon efficacy data.
- f. Under directions for crack and crevice identify the type of equipment capable of delivering a pin stream or delete. We doubt the layperson would have such equipment unless it is sold with the product.
- g. Under block 15 of the confidential statement of formula change insect growth regulator to insecticide for prallethrin. We have no information indicating prallethrin is an insect growth regulator.
- 3. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake Well Before Use

General: Use this spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, fleas, silverfish, ticks, waterbugs and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food handling surfaces.

For Spot Treatment to Kill Ants, Black Widow Spiders, Carpet Beetles, Centipedes, Cigarette Beetles, Cockroaches, Confused Flour Beetles, Crickets, Indian Meal Moths, Rice Weevils, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs and Spiders: Spray areas where these insects are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For Ants spray ant trails and around doors and windows, and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary. For control of Black Carpet Beetles, spray along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Pet's old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after eatment. Do not spray pets with this product. Pets should be treated with a flea and tick control product registered for use on pets prior to reentering treated areas.

For Crack and Crevice Treatment to Kill Ants, Black Widow Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs and Spiders: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where these insects hide.

For Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only outdoors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and doorframes as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame. Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

First Aid
