### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product may be used both indoors (attics and other places where nests are built and where food or feed are not exposed) and outdoors for controlling hornet, wasp and yellowjacket nests.

**For control of hornet, wasp and yellow jacket nests:** The best time to spray is in the early morning or early evening when air temperature is cooler, most insects are in the nest and little activity is observed around the nest opening. Spray only if it is not windy. Stand a safe distance from the nest, not directly underneath it. Hold container upright at arms' length, point the actuator at nest and spray the opening of the nest. Then spray the rest of the nest until it is saturated. Treated insects will fall out of the nest and die. Any insects returning to the treated nest will also be killed. Wait 48 hours before removing the nest. Foliage of desirable plants contacted during spraying should be hosed off with water.

**For control of ants and spiders (outdoors only):** For ants and spiders found in areas such as electric service boxes, water meter boxes, telephone boxes, along house foundation, foundation vents, sills and ledges, etc., spray in short bursts to contact pests. Ant trails, runways and hills should also be sprayed as necessary. Do not spray foliage of desirable plants. If spray does contact foliage, hose off with water.

### Storage and Disposal

**Storage:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame. **Disposal:** Offer empty container for metal recycling where available. In areas where recycling is not available, or if container has not been emptied during use, attached overcap and dispose of in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

**CAUTION:** Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, food storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

#### First Aid

#### Physical or Chemical Hazards
