DIRECTIONS

TO KILL ROACHES, ANTS AND SILVERFISH, dust the powder liberally into all cracks and crevices from which these insects emerge or through which they may be entering the building. Particularly to openings through walls and floors, kitchen cabinets and pantry shelves. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL FLEAS AND LICE ON PET ANIMALS, dust the powder into the coat, working it into contact with the skin. The dead and stupefied insects should be brushed or combed from the coat, collected on paper and burned. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL LICE ON POULTRY AND PET BIRDS, dust the powder carefully into the feathers, under the wings, along the back and around the vent. Rub a pinch or two into the feathers of the head. Nests, roosts and runways should be thoroughly cleaned and dusted. Perches and cages should be thoroughly cleaned and dusted after destroying infested food or cuttlebone. Repeat as necessary.
