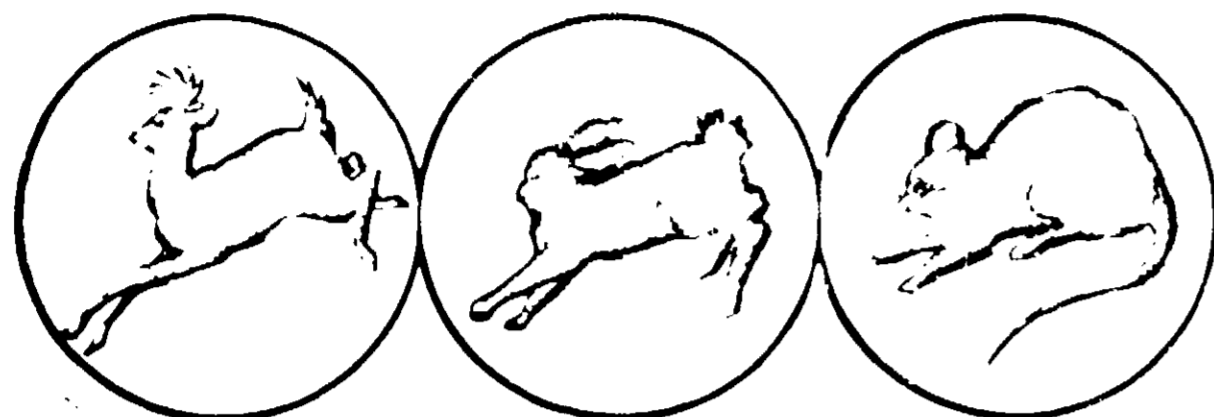

HOW MUCH TO USE:

Application rates (dilution of TAT GO with water) depend upon season, intensity of animal problem, length of protection needed, and degree of control desired in relation to value of crop and cost involved. The following ratios are suggested. (Note: 1:2 means use 1 part TAT GO to 2 parts water).

	Summer or Winter	*Winter	**Summer
Rabbits	1:2	1:6	1:16
Deer	1:2	1:4	1:9
Meadow Mice	1:1		

*Suggested rate if only light or moderate damage is anticipated, and if prolonged effectiveness is not required.

READ BEFORE USING:

Shake well before use.
 Use diluted spray within 1 week after mixing.
 Wash out equipment with water immediately after use.
 Reapply repellent when plant puts on untreated new growth.
 Do not apply to garden greens such as lettuce, cabbage, etc.
 Do not apply to other vegetables and fruits after edible parts have begun to form.
 Do not feed treated plants or plant residue to livestock.
 Freezing will not destroy TAT GO concentrate.
 Repellent films may be removed from skin with such solvents as lighter fluid, mineral spirits, turpentine, etc.

DIRECTIONS: DO NOT USE FOR CHILDREN, SUCH AS COOKIES, SLICES OF BREAD, ETC. WILL ACTIVELY SEARCH FOR FOOD. USE IN PROOF BAIT BOXES, OR IN AREAS WHERE YOU WANT TO KILL RATS AND MICE: MIX WITH EQUAL PARTS OF SUITABLE BAIT MATERIAL. PLACE IN A SMALL PIECE OF PAPER. REPEAT AT INTERVALS OF ABOUT TEN DAYS. EXPERIMENTS HAVE BEEN OBSERVED TO DESTROY OLD BAIT IN THREE DAYS. DESTROY OLD BAIT TO KILL ROACHES AND WATER BEETLES. USE THICK SLICES OF RAW POTATOES IN INFESTED AREAS. REPEAT TREATMENT FOR SEVERE INFESTATIONS. FRESH BAIT EACH TIME.

PROCEDURE FOR SAFE DISPOSAL: CAN BE EMPTYED IN ISOLATED AREA. POUR A SMALL AMOUNT OF WATER IN A TABLESPOONFUL OF ANY CONTAINER THOROUGHLY. CRUSH AND DISPOSE. DO NOT USE IN COMMERCIAL OR RESIDENTIAL AREAS OF FOOD STORAGE. TO BE USED IN COMMERCIAL
