Follow same directions as above and place in spots where ants forage.
Results with J-O Paste will not be fully evident for several days depending on conditions. Re-treat as necessary to effect and maintain control.

TO KILL ROACHES: AMERICAN, BROWN-BANDED, GERMAN and ORIENTAL:
Use a flat stick or spatula, place a generous amount of J-O Paste, the size of a small walnut in the center of a 5 or 6 inch square piece of either wax paper or aluminum foil. Place a number of these in infested areas. Use behind or under fixtures where roaches are seen. When paste hardens discard.

Repeat treatment for several alternate nights, be sure to use fresh paste each time. Good sanitation practices should also be followed.
