

## STERLING AQUATIC WEEDKILLER

Sterling Aquatic Weedkiller is a highly aromatic emulsifiable petroleum hydrocarbon weedkiller for use in controlling submersed waterweeds in irrigation canals. It is toxic to waterweeds such as:

Algae Elodea Sago Pondweed Coontail Moss

### DIRECTIONS

Condition of Waterweeds	Use Sterling Aquatic Weedkiller
Susceptible - Algae & Moss	300 P.P.M.
Intermediate	750 P.P.M.
Resistant - Pondweed Species	1200 P.P.M.

Spray Sterling Aquatic Weedkiller through nozzles placed under water directed against current. Use adequate pressure to insure proper dispersion. Reduce flow of water so it just covers moss - apply with about 100 pounds of pressure and point nozzles upstream under water practically on bottom and work nozzles back and forth across ditch. Apply for 30 minutes at rate of 5 gallons per 30 minutes for each cubic foot per second of water (i.e. 6 cubic foot per second stream apply 30 gallons in 30 minutes.) This will give chemical concentrations of 370 parts per million. (Heavy infestations, mature and resistant weeds and water temperatures below 60 degrees F. may require double or triple usages.)

A milky suspension will be formed in the water (like creamy color). When this changes to light bluish color another application should be made. This will usually take place 1/4 to 3/4 mile down the ditch from the first place of application, depending on temperature of the water, speed of flow, etc. etc. etc. Be sure to make one or 2nd, 3rd, 4th applications, downstream. Determine location of various stations below first one by appearance of water color. If in doubt, consult local agricultural authorities.

If sprayer puts out too many gallons per minute, Aquatic Weedkiller can be diluted with water accordingly.
