



CHEVRON WEED KILLER 357

Active Ingredients: Petroleum Oils 100%
(Aromatic Content 20%)

When used as a Selective Weed Killer to Control Weeds and Grasses in Carrot Crops Observe the Following Directions:

For best results apply when the weeds are young and preferably after the carrots have 2 true leaves. Do not apply later than 6 weeks before harvest because of the hazard of imparting oil flavor to carrots. Apply at the rate of 50 gallons per acre to control normal weed infestations.

DILL FIELDS. When dill is in 2-4 fern leaf stage, spray at the rate of 20 to 75 gallons maximum per acre, dependent upon density of the weed, prior to 31 days' weed growth or a maximum of two inches in weed height. Another application can be made four to six weeks later, however, weed growth shall not exceed the two inches in height prior to the second application. Best results are

obtained when product is sprayed at the pressure of 40 to 60 P.S.I. straight down or at a 65° angle, depending upon weed height. Do not spray when wind is in excess of six to eight miles per hour.
