**DIRECTIONS**

Chevron Weed Oil is a light-bodied highly aromatic petroleum oil, which may be diluted up to 2 parts water with one part oil for general control of most annual and many perennial weeds in ditch banks, along roadways, fence lines, railroad right of way, and in orchards, vineyards or groves where non-cultivated crops are grown. Also used as a preemergence weed killer on such crops as sweetcorn, onions and tomatoes. Use 20-40 gallons per acre. Application to be made at a minimum 48 hours prior to anticipated plant emergence from the soil. Spray sufficient on all weeds to be killed to completely cover them with a thin film of oil. Chevron Weed Oil will kill practically all plants when applying to orchard floor, grapevines, and grape vineyards. Use a directed spray and avoid crop stems and foliage. Apply carefully to prevent oil from contacting valuable plants and trees.
