### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Dosages and methods of application given here are general—consult your state agricultural experiment station or extension service for local recommendation.

Use STOP-SCALD to control scald of Anjou pears and common scald only on the following susceptible apple varieties:

By Dipping or Post-Harvest Spray to Runoff

Baldwin*	Red Rome*
Cortland*	Red Stayman
McIntosh	King of the Hill Greening
Red Delicious*	Wesley
	York Imperial

May be treated by Pre-Harvest Tree Spray also. For Pre-Harvest Tree Spray application, daily temperature maximum remains below 85° F.

Do not use on any other varieties of apples.

Do not allow STOP-SCALD concentrate or diluted tank mixture to drop below 32° F. If allowed to freeze, warm concentrate in tank, stir, and re-disperse.

For spraying and application add STOP-SCALD to the spray or dip tank while filling the tank with water and mix thoroughly. Maintain efficient agitation in dip tank mixture to assure a uniform suspension.

**PRE-HARVEST APPLICATION** to apples: use 3 pints in 100 gallons of water and spray within 2 days of harvest. Apply as a full cover spray with standard hydraulic spray equipment or with a speed sprayer or other air blast equipment at dilute concentration.

**POST-HARVEST TREATMENT** of apples and Anjou pears: use 2 to 3 pints in 100 gallons of water. For pears use a 15 second dip. For apples use as a 15 second dip or spray prior to or as the fruit passes over the grading line. Apply no longer than one week after harvest to help insure adequate control of scald. Change solution daily.

**ATTENTION**—Apply STOP-SCALD only as recommended on this label and do not use on other crops. Such application or use may damage other crops. Keep out of drinking water and water used for domestic purposes. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Exposure to air may result in darkening of the product. This does not affect the performance of the product. Before spraying, check all hose connections to see that they are firmly attached.

### GROWTH REGULATOR FOR COMMON SCALD.

Apply as Post-Harvest treatment for Anjou Pears and as a Pre-Harvest or Post-Harvest treatment to control common scald of Susceptible Apple Varieties in storage.

Use only according to these label instructions.
