This is in response to your resubmission of revised Confidential Statements of Formula and labels for the above named products. The following comments apply.

1. The revised updated Confidential Statements of Formula dated June 2, 1993 are in compliance with PR Notice 91-2 and they agree with the label claims.
2. Please provide the Agency with a pH of these products with a 1% or other water dilution.

The labels referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable subject to the comments indicated below. Please submit five copies of the revised labels incorporating these changes before shipment of each product bearing the amended labeling. Stamped copies of the labels are enclosed for your records.

\*In the revised labels under the heading Physical or Chemical Hazards change word "Combustible" to "Flammable".

\*The net weight should be in US measure, then it may be followed in metric measure. It should be Net Weight 55 pounds (25kg).

**Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals**

**Storage and Disposal**

**STORAGE:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. In case of leak or spill, In case of leak or spill, shut off or extinguish all sources of ignition. Shut off leak if without risk. Small spills, keep upwind. Large spills, evacuate area. If necessary to enter spill area, wear self-contained breathing apparatus and full protective clothing including boots. Sweep up or shovel into clean metal containers. Dispose of pesticide and container in accordance with instructions provided under DISPOSAL below.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
