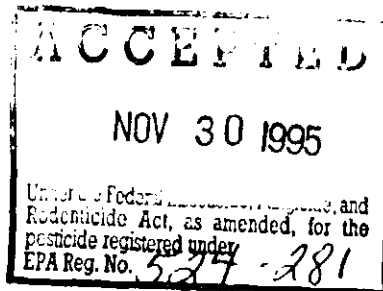

Storage and Disposal

Small spills, keep upwind. Large spills, evacuate area. If necessary to enter spill area, wear self-contained breathing apparatus and full protective clothing including boots. Sweep up or shovel into clean metal containers. Dispose of pesticide and containers in accordance with instructions provided under **DISPOSAL** below.
