Please submit five copies of the revised labels incorporating these changes before shipment of each product bearing the amended labeling. Stamped copies of the labels are enclosed for your records.

•In the revised labels under the heading Physical or Chemical Hazards change word "Combustible" to "Flammable".

\*The net weight should be in US measure, then it may be followed in metric measure. It should be Net Weight 55 pounds (25kg).

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## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

## Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

#### DANGER

#### Storage and Disposal

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Material will melt at 127°F. Do not store at elevated temperatures. In case of leak or spill, sweep up or shovel into clean metal containers. Dispose of pesticide and container in accordance with instructions provided under DISPOSAL below.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
