The revised basic Confidential Statement of Formula dated April 27, 1995 is in compliance with PR Notice 91-2. It agrees with the label and it is acceptable.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comment indicated below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. The net weight statement should be in U.S. measure. Then it may be followed by metric measure. It should be "Net Weight 55 pounds (25 Kg)."

Submit one (1) copy of the final printed label prior to release of the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

W A R N I N G

CAUSES EYE, SKIN AND RESPIRATORY TRACT IRRITATION. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED.

Directions for Use

FOR USE BY MANUFACTURERS, FORMULATORS AND REPACKAGERS to produce end-use products for indoor general use pattern only. When this product is prepared as an end use pesticide, manufacturers, formulators and repackagers must obtain their own EPA Registration Number.

Storage and Disposal

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Material will melt at 127°F. Do not store at elevated temperatures. In case of leak or spill, sweep up or shovel into clean metal containers. Dispose of pesticide and container in accordance with instructions provided under **DISPOSAL** below.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or if swallowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke. Emptied container retains vapors and product residue. Observe all labeled safeguards until container is destroyed.
